RE: Site visit

January 27, 2021, I, Rachel Neisius conducted air quality monitoring in the Mead area at 2:15 pm. Investigation was conducted in response to continuing concerns from area residents smelling foul odors and improper use of wet cake. It was 18 °F, sunny, with winds out of the NW at approximately 0-5mph.

Observations:

- 1) I drove Road 10 past the facility, and saw multiple semis with hopper style trailers sitting at the facility.
- 2) I stopped and viewed the facility from county road K, so I could see the entrance of the facility. I saw no semis leave the facility, and one arrive during the time I was there.
- 3) I saw no activity near the wet cake pile while I was monitoring.
- 4) The wetcake pile was steaming and had no snow on it. There was a reported 10+ inches snow fall two days prior.
- 5) I saw the blue metal shipping container and two small augers by the wet cake pile. They seem to be in the same place as the prior visit on 1/21/21.
- 6) I left the site at about 2:45 pm.
