Quality-Assessed Agrichemical Contaminant Database for Nebraska Ground Water

Status 4-23-2019

We have about 495,000 analytical results representing over 28,500 wells. Approximately 129,800 of these results are nitrate results.

Data for 2018 have been received from 17 NRDs. UNWNRD submitted data for 2017 as well. We do not have 2018 data from CPNRD, LPNRD, LRNRD, MRNRD, NPNRD, and the USGS (for Papio-Missouri River NRD).

Processing was completed for Department of Agriculture ELISA (Enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay) data from the Department of Agriculture for 2017 and the data added to the ELISA website. We now have over 3,700 ELISA results in the clearinghouse representing 4 analytes, acetochlor, alachlor, atrazine, and metolachlor.

We will begin processing 2018 data soon for the Quality-Assessed Clearinghouse.
