Natural Gas Service Providers and Their Prices in Nebraska 2004

In 2004, the <u>residential sector</u> paid an average of \$9.06 per thousand <u>cubic feet</u> for natural gas, the <u>commercial sector</u> paid \$7.60, the <u>industrial sector</u> paid \$6.68, and the <u>electric power sector</u> paid \$6.51.

The state's natural gas was supplied by twenty companies whose average 2004 residential rates ranged from Hastings Utilities' \$5.68 to the City of Stromsburg's \$12.02 per thousand cubic feet. Commercial rates ranged from Hastings Utilities' \$5.17 to the City of Falls City's \$11.35. Rates for natural gas used by electric utilities ranged from Hastings Utilities' \$6.09 to the City of Wahoo's \$9.58. Industrial rates ranged from the City of Wisner's \$4.74 to the City of Stromsburg's \$10.31.
