The Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) offers a streamlined process to complete environmental cleanups efficiently and effectively!

NDEQ's Surface Water Unit monitors streams, determining the current water quality, and whether the water is safe for people to consume; and for recreation, fish consumption, and industrial or agricultural uses.

But that's only part of the story... the NDEQ Groundwater Unit reviews various projects and programs to determine possible effects on groundwater quality.

Do you need help correcting onsite wastewater system failures?

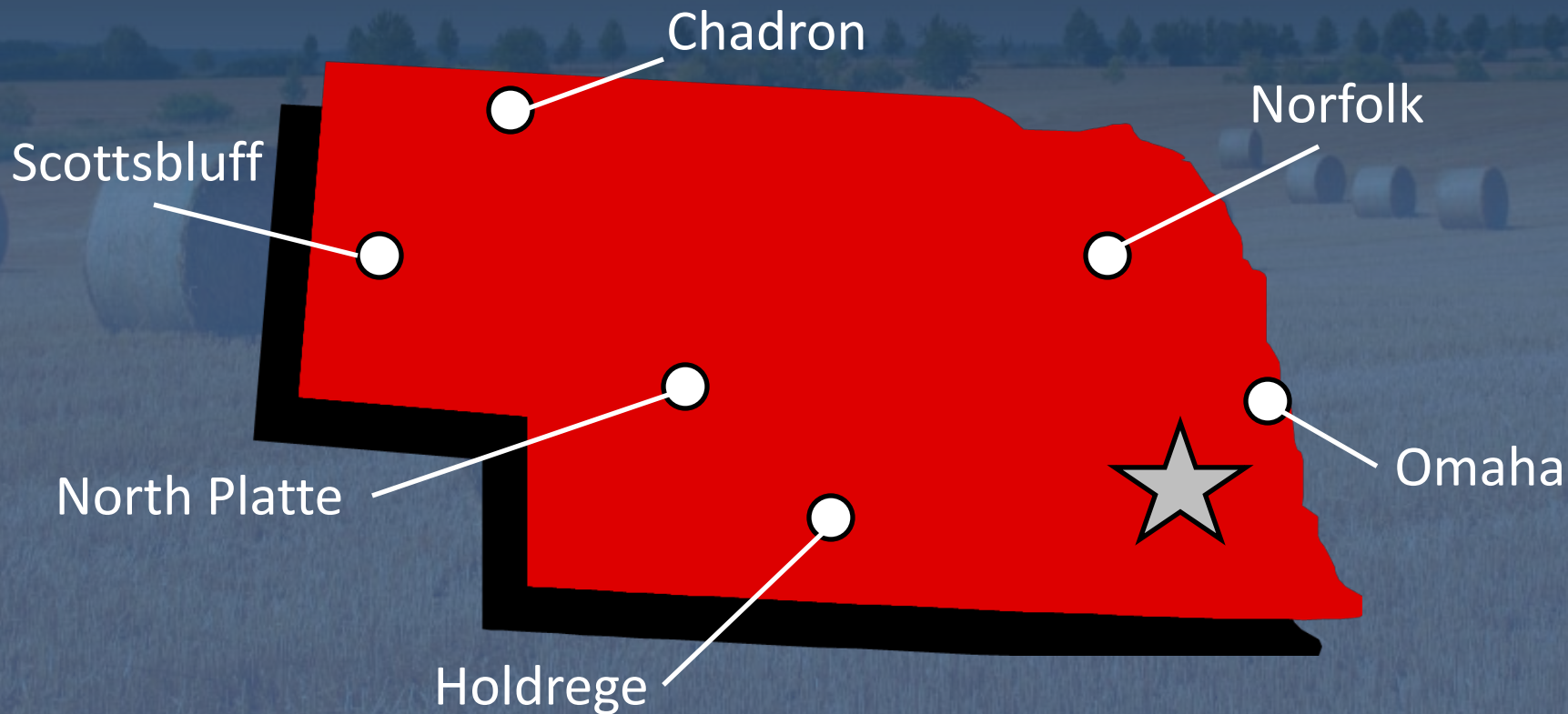

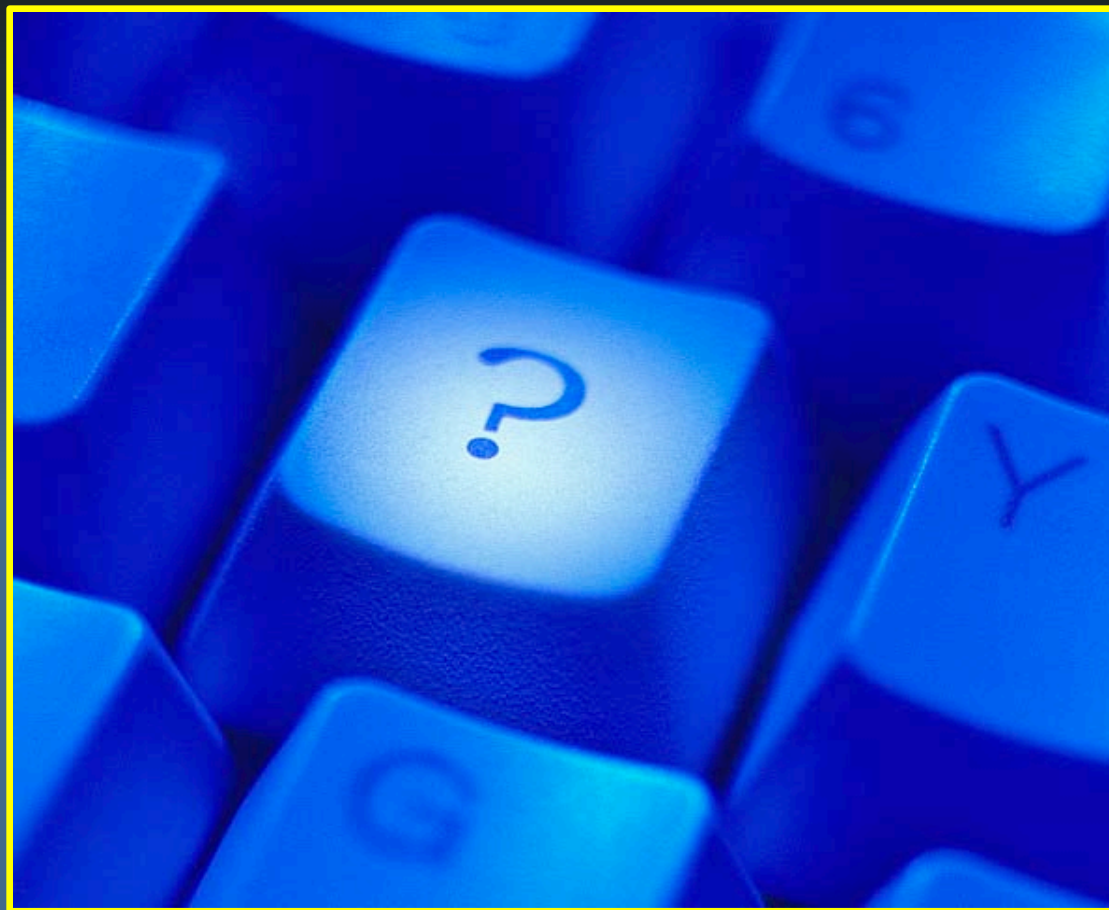

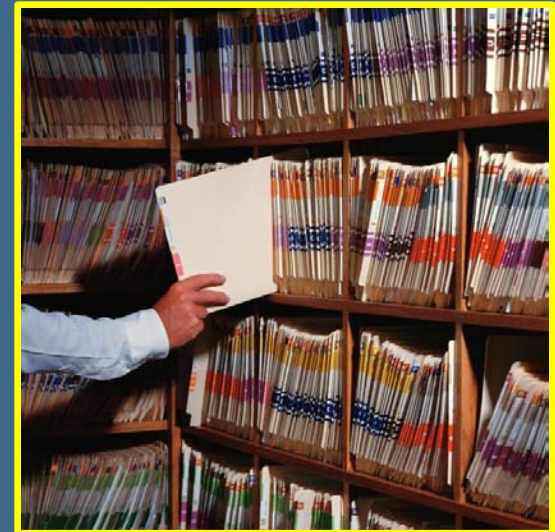
