Authorization to Discharge Under the
National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System
(NPDES)

General NPDES Permit Number NER900000

For Storm Water Discharges

From Industrial Activity to Waters of the State of
Nebraska

- Effective July 1, 2011
- Includes Qualitative Monitoring
- May Include Benchmark Sampling for Some Industrial Sectors
- Does Not Supersede Individual Permit Requirements

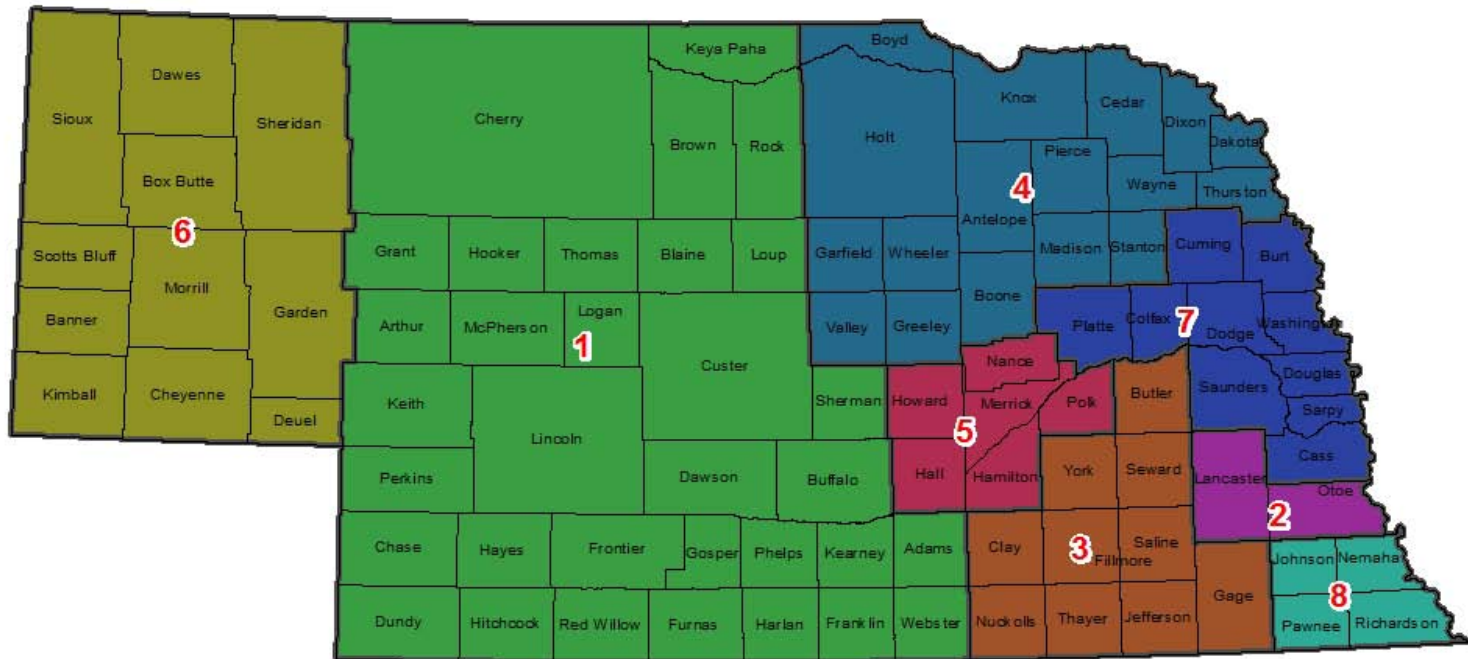
Common Issues

- Lack of Required Coverage
 - Industry Specific
 - Categorical Listing
 - General Permit vs. No Exposure Certification
 - 11 Point Exposure Checklist
- Incomplete Notice of Intent
 - Site Map
 - Site Diagram
 - Receiving Water
 - Certifying Official

Inspection Emphasis

- Documentation
 - Authorization
 - Notice of Intent
 - No Exposure Certification
 - Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)
 - Routine Inspections
 - Quarterly Visual
 - Comprehensive Annual
 - Outfalls Defined
 - Benchmark Monitoring
 - SWPPP Reviews and Updates
 - Corrective Actions
 - Housekeeping
 - Physical Characteristics
