



Community Public Water Systems Status





Non-Community Public Water Systems Status





• Boyd County Rural Water District #2 has installed a new transmission line and it has been placed into service. Water samples from all three systems, which include a rural system and the villages of Lynch and Spencer, will be collected to confirm the absence of coliform bacteria before removing the boil-water advisory.
