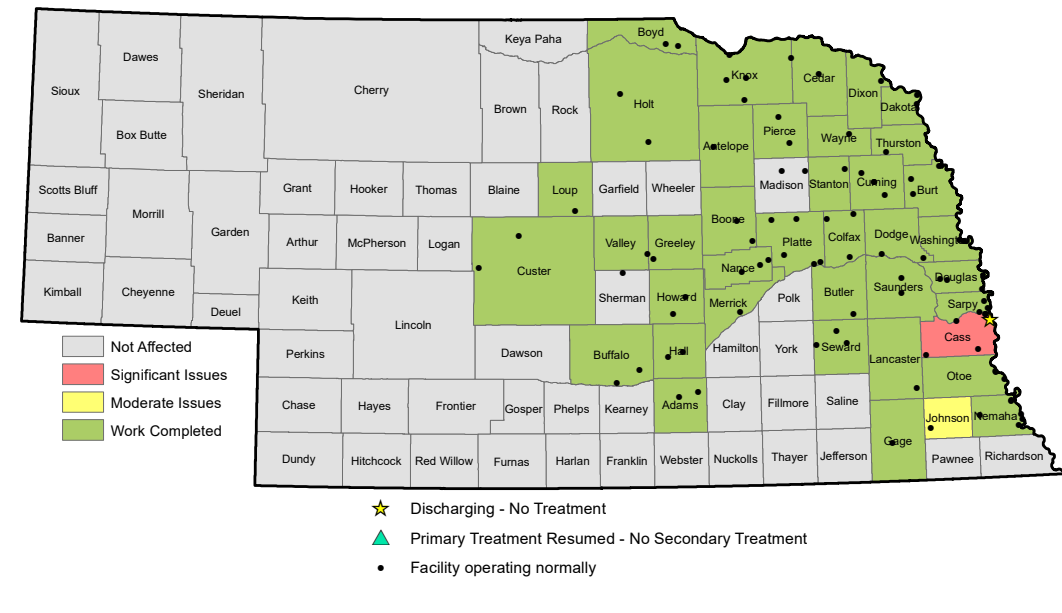
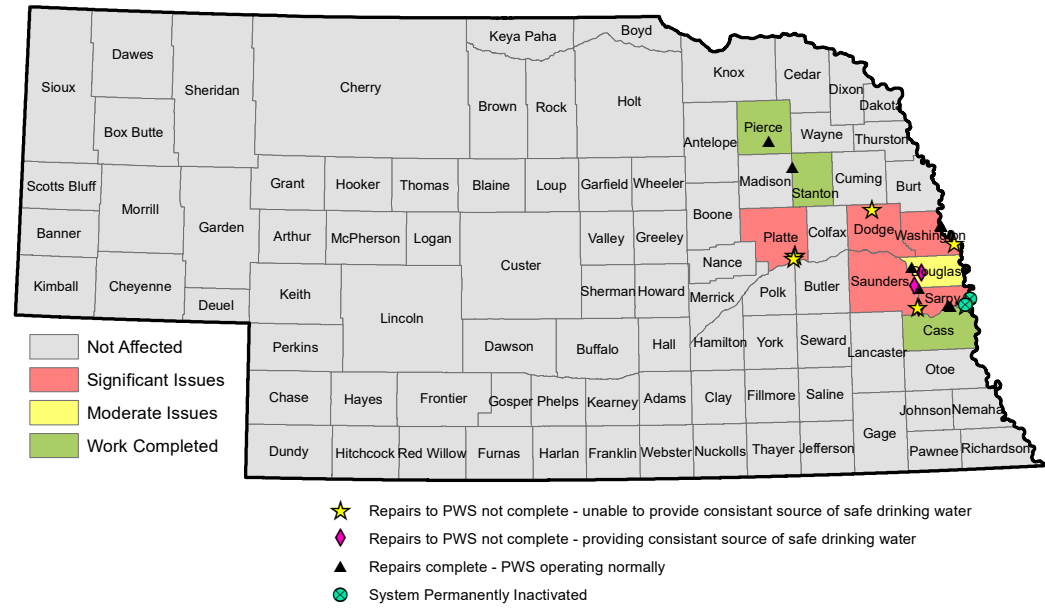
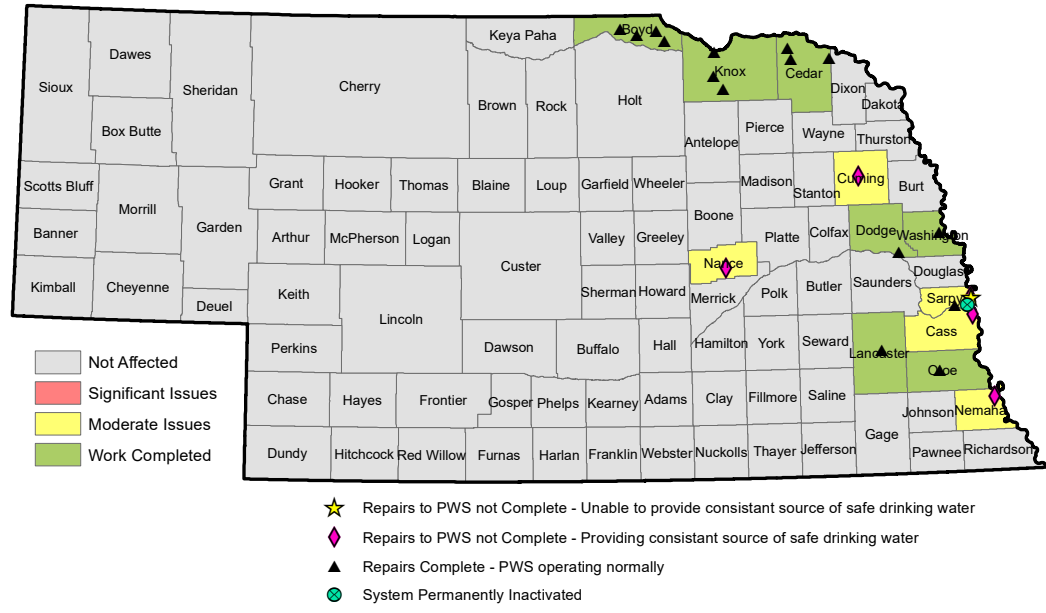

**Wastewater Facility Status**

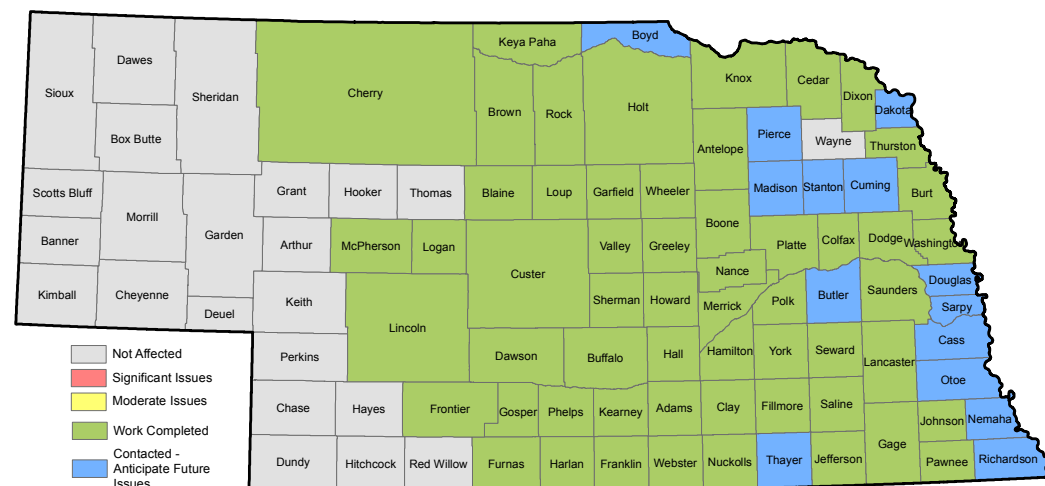
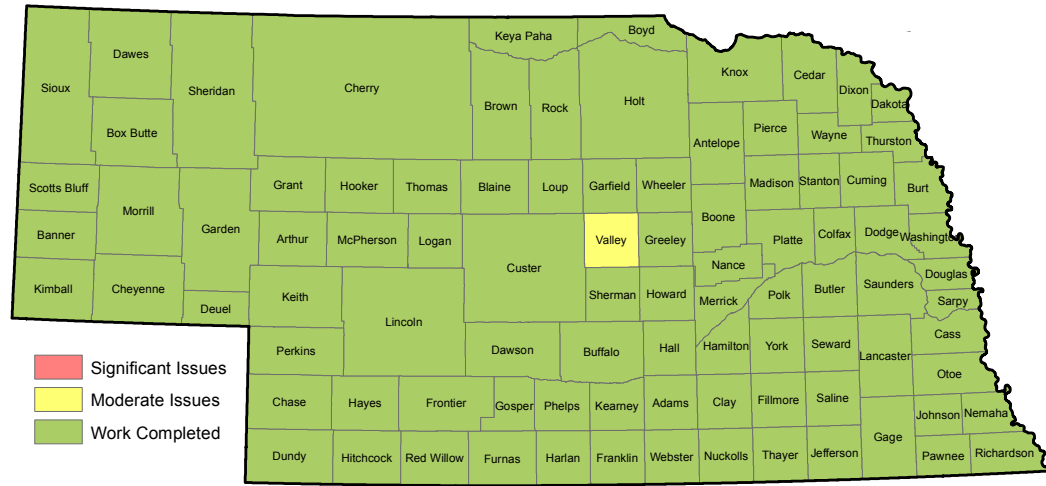
