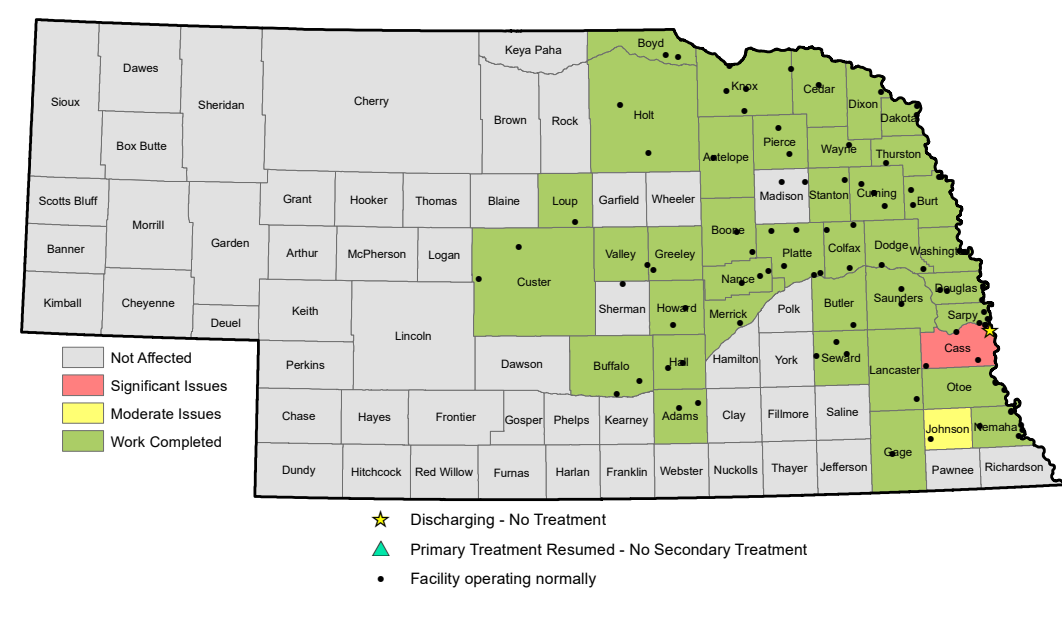
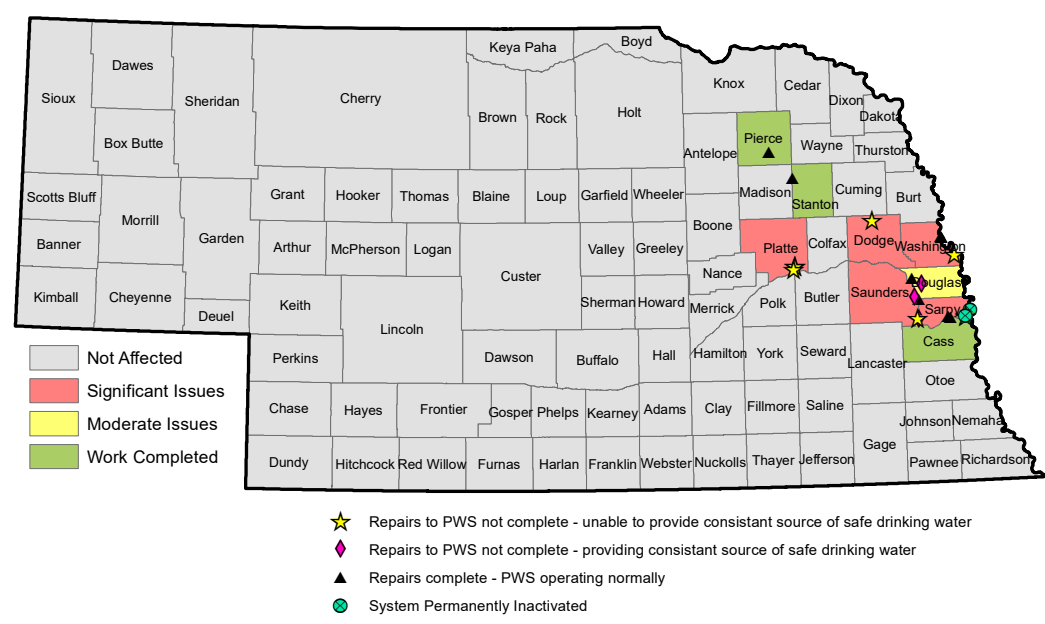
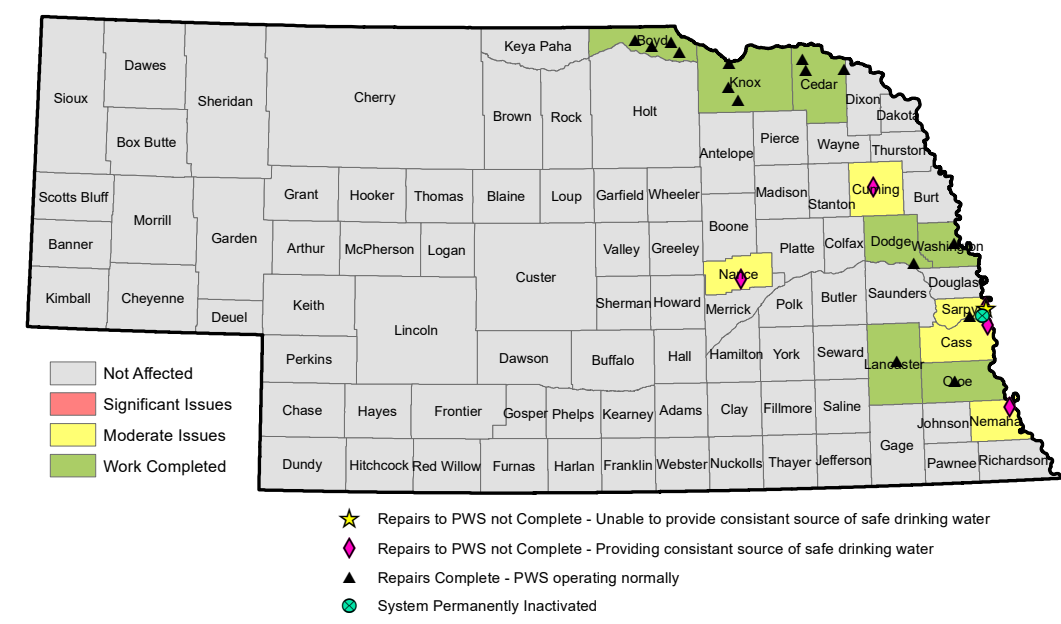


Community Public Water Systems Status

Wastewater Facility Status

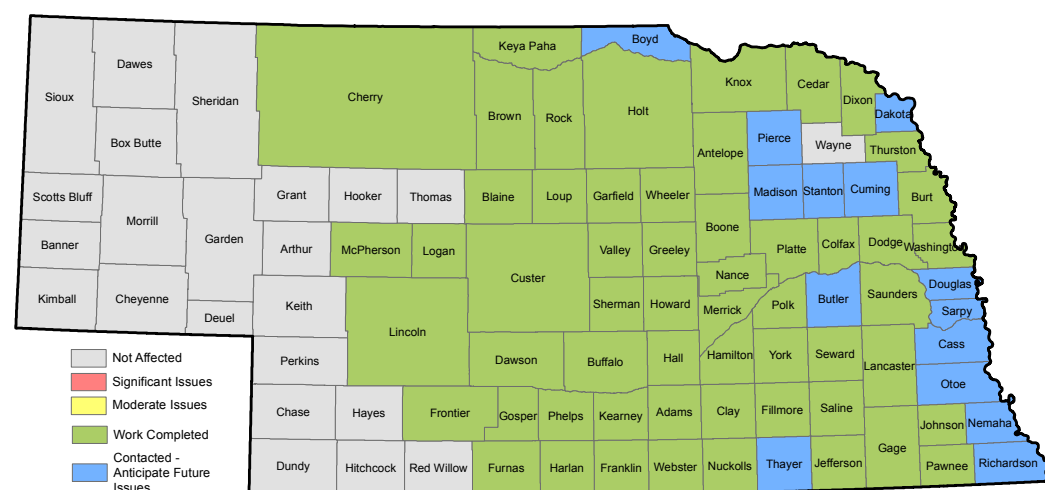
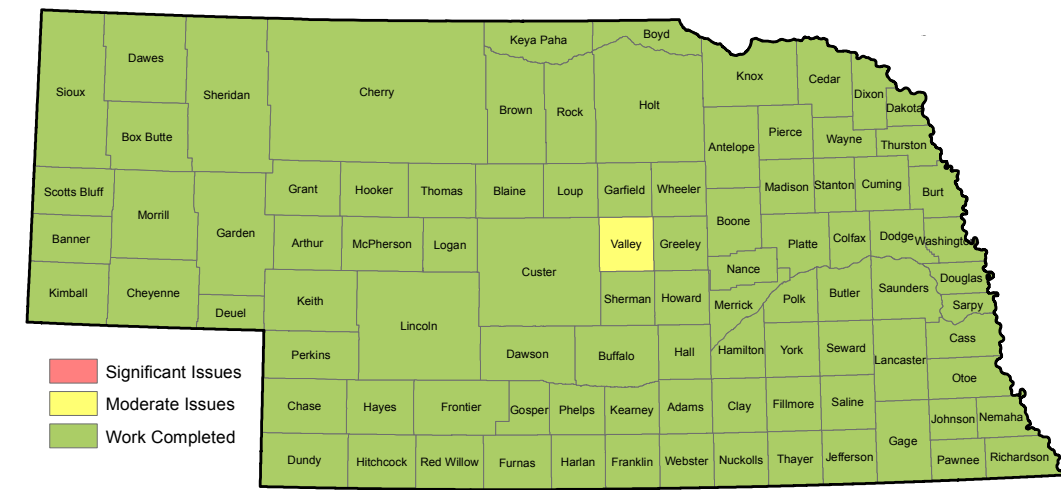


Livestock Facility Status

• Currently, three community PWS, and seven non-community PWS with primary sources of water still off-line

Objectives:
• Work with a livestock waste control facilities (LWCF) and wastewater treatment facilities

Status:
• Working with the Plattsmouth WWTF and Crab Orchard's WWTF in their recovery efforts

Objective:
• Administer weatherization and loan programs

Status:
• Offered the Dollar and Energy Savings Loan at 1% interest for March flooding. As of Oct. 16: 102 loans committed for \$2,024,538.49
14 loans entered (not yet committed) for \$336,835.98
56 loans participated for \$761,640.37
