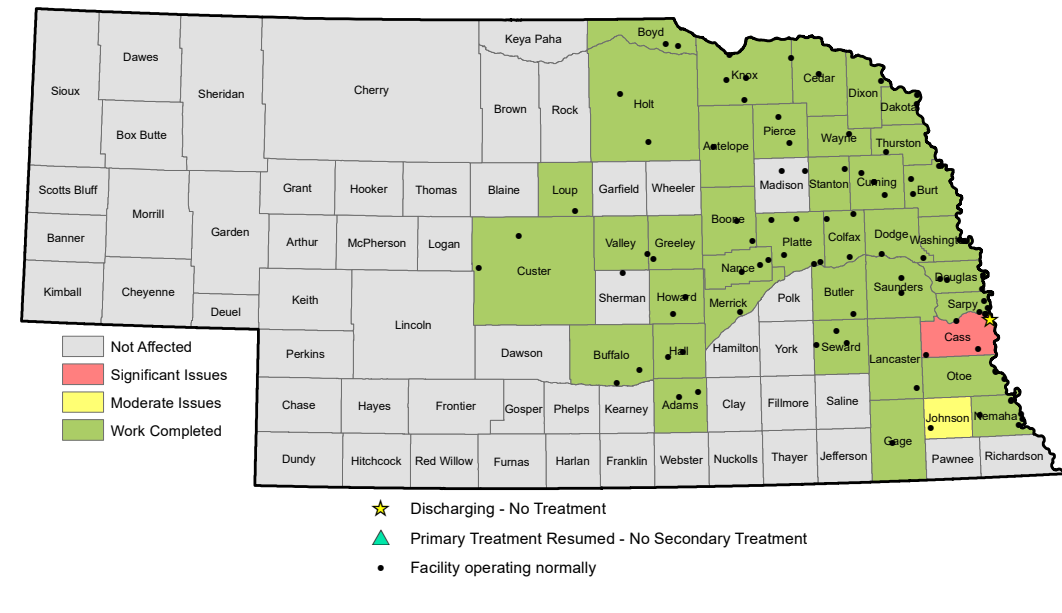
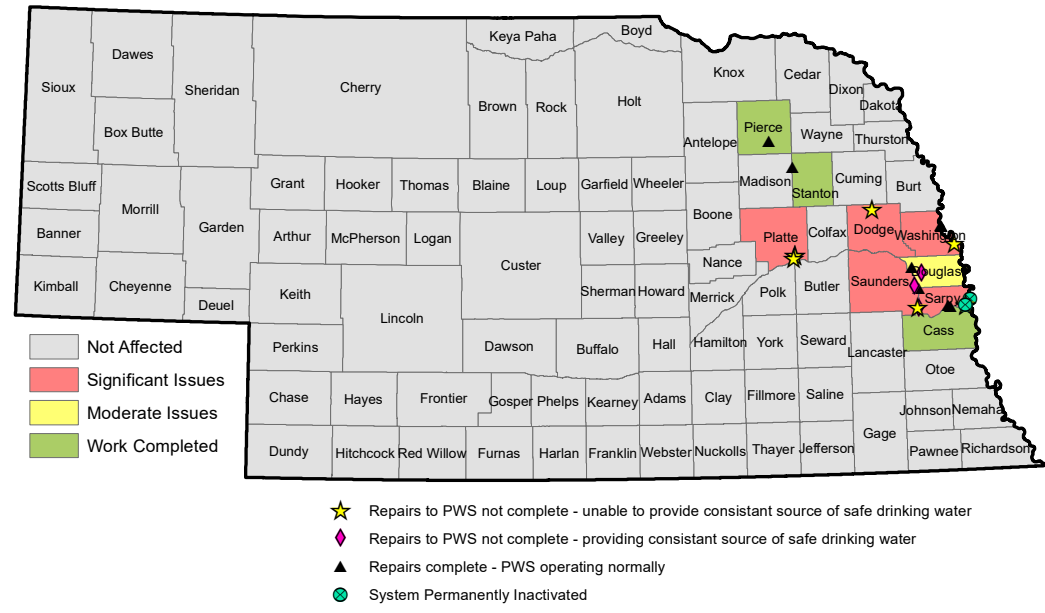
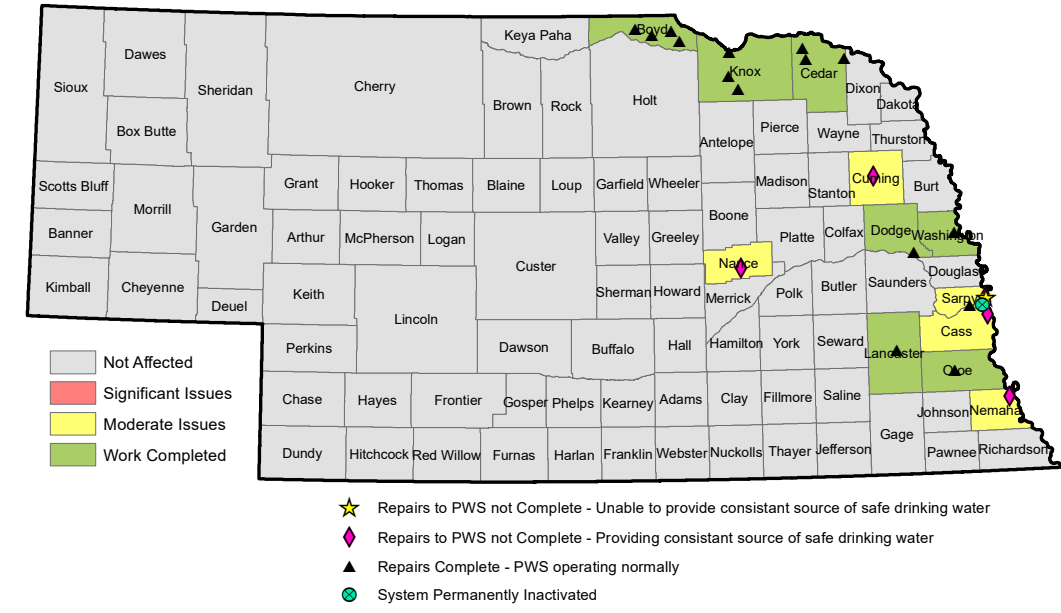


Community Public Water Systems Status

Wastewater Facility Status

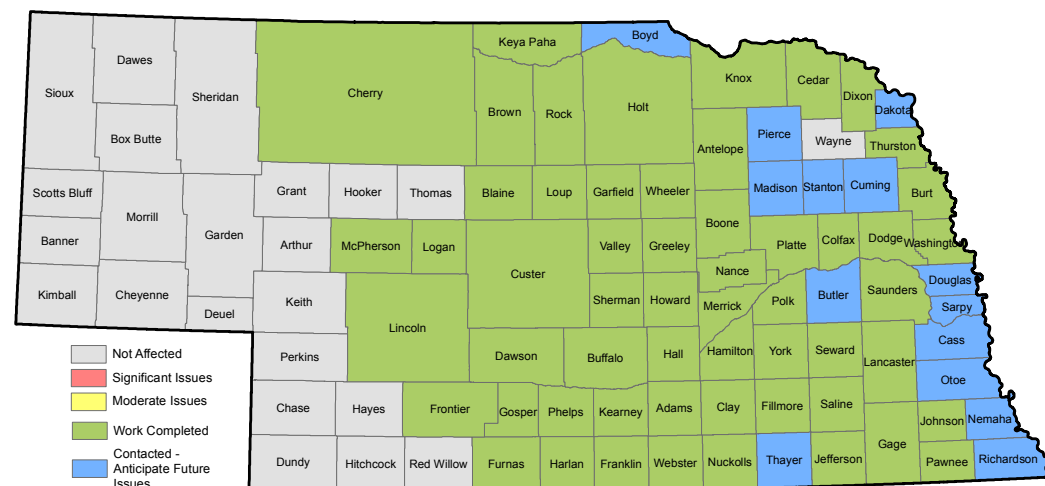
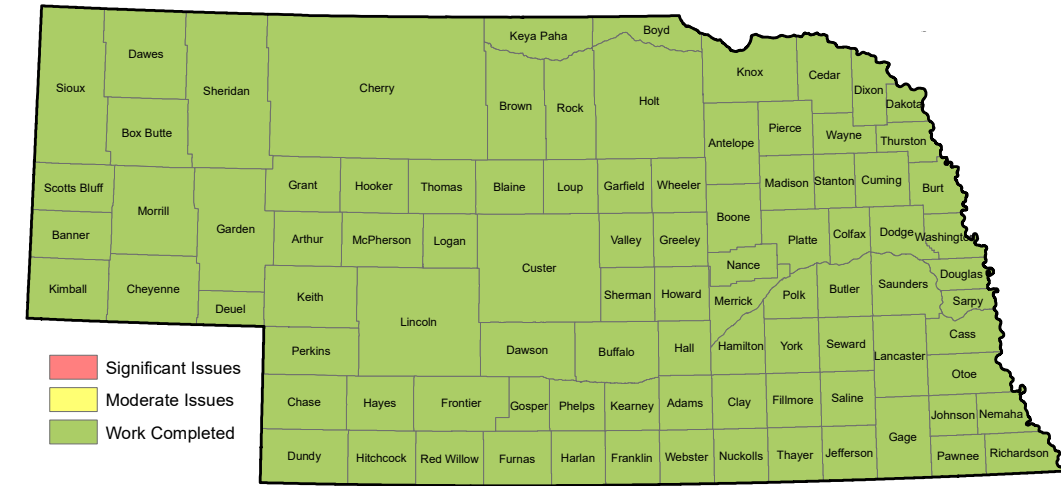


Livestock Facility Status
