Common Hazardous Waste violations

- 1. Failure to make hazardous waste determinations
- 2. Failure to update notification information.
- 3. Failure to close container holding hazardous waste (SQG and LQG)
- 4. Failure to label hazardous waste containers (Satellite and Accumulation)
- 5. Failure to date hazardous waste accumulation containers
- 6. Failure to place emergency information next to the phone (SQG)
- 7. Failure to update contingency plan (LQG)
- 8. Failure to conduct and/or document hazardous waste training (LQG)
- 9. Storage of hazardous waste over 90 or 180 days (LQG / SQG)
- 10. Failure to label a container holding 25 gallons or more of used oil with the words "used oil"
- 11. Failure to make arrangements with local authorities (SQG and LQG).
- 12. Failure to properly label universal waste containers and keep them closed (as necessary)
- 13. Failure to conduct weekly inspections
- 14. Failure to properly manifest, fill out land disposal restriction form, or receive manifest back within 35 days or submit exception report within 45 days (60 days for SQG).
