Reminders:

- This checklist is provided as a courtesy to help with typical onsite wastewater treatment system permit related requirements. Additional regulatory requirements may apply.
- Please check for local requirements which are separate and may be different than Title 124 requirements.
- Permit applications are reviewed in the order received by the Department. Please allow sufficient time in your planning for application preparation, review, and any needed clarifications or revisions, some of which may require additional field work. The Department may request additional information as needed for its review and permit decision.
- When a permit application is required, Title 124 requires a construction permit prior to any onsite system construction and an operating permit prior to wastewater discharge to or any use of the onsite system.
- When a construction permit is issued, Title 124 requires that any modifications, revisions, or changes to the system or design be approved by DWEE prior to changes being made to the system.
- Title 124 requires system registration (Installer) and certification of completion (Engineer) before an
 operating permit can be issued.

For purposes of system registration, the Department has interpreted completion of work to mean that all onsite wastewater treatment system components have been installed, constructed or modified so that the system piping, treatment devices or other appurtenances that convey, treat or dispose of wastewater are ready to be used. The DWEE does not consider construction completion of an onsite system to be dependent upon construction of any dwelling or building to which the system may be connected, final grading, seeding, or the date of receipt of payment for work performed.
