## **Onsite Wastewater Fee Schedule**

The chart below identifies Onsite Wastewater Program fees associated with obtaining Professional Certification (examination, hardship and renewal), registration of onsite systems, permits and subdivision review and approvals as described in Appendix A of <u>Title 124</u>.

Examination Fee – Must be paid for each test administered		\$50
Certificate by Examination, Certificate by Hardship, or Certificate Renewal	Master Installer, Master Pumper, Soil Evaluator, or Inspector	\$300
	Journeyman Installer or Journeyman Pumper	\$100
Late Renewal Penalty (0-60 days after certificate expiration)		\$50
System Registration within ≤45 days		\$140
Late Registration Fee – Must be paid in addition to System Registration Fee	Initial (46-90 days)	\$150
	Final (≥91 days)	\$450
Application for Construction/Operating Permit		\$450
Application for Subdivision Review and Approval		\$450 per lot
