<b>AC</b>	Agricultural Chemicals	Secondary containment around agricultural chemical storage.
<b>AIR</b>	Air Quality Program	Compliance, Monitoring, and Permitting of Air Quality Regulations.
<b>ASB</b>	Asbestos Abatement Remediation	Notification from facilities doing demolition and renovation involving asbestos.
<b>BF</b>	Brownfields	Redevelopment of abandoned or underused industrial or commercial properties.
<b>CR</b>	Continuous Release	Reporting of routine chemical releases.
<b>CSW</b>	Construction Storm Water	NPDES permit program for storm water discharges from construction sites.
<b>CWSRF</b>	Clean Water State Revolving Fund	Loans for wastewater projects.
<b>CHM</b>	Chemigation	Licensing program responsible for protecting the irrigation water source from contamination by fertilizer or pesticides.
<b>DERA</b>	Diesel Emission Reduction Act	Funds grants and rebates that protect human health and improve air quality by reducing harmful emissions from diesel engines.
<b>DESL</b>	Dollar Energy Savings and Loans	Pre-approved projects for home and building improvements can be financed with a low-interest loan.
<b>DWE</b>	Drinking Water Engineering	Engineering review of plans and specs for Drinking Water facilities
<b>DWP</b>	Drinking Water Program	Compliance and permitting of drinking water facilities
<b>DWSRF</b>	Drinking Water State Revolving Fund	Loans for drinking projects
<b>EA</b>	Environmental Assistance	Assistance and coordination offered for environmental issues
<b>ESE</b>	Environmental Safety Engineering	Engineering documentation for the environmental safety of pools, mobile home parks, & campgrounds
<b>ESP</b>	Environmental Safety Program	Environmental safety of pools, mobile home parks, campgrounds, childcare centers, senior centers, schools, and well & septic evaluations.
<b>GPU</b>	Grants and Planning Unit	Grants for Litter Reduction and Recycling Program, Waste Reduction and Recycling Program
<b>GW</b>	Ground Water	Sites undergoing cleanup of groundwater under Title 118
<b>HCP</b>	Haul, Collect, and Process Tires	Grants for recycling all used, scrap or unwanted tires
<b>IWM</b>	Integrated Waste Management	Facilities (landfills) for the disposal of municipal solid waste, construction and demolition debris, fossil fuel ash, and industrial waste
<b>LGL</b>	Legal	Program for Legal Enforcement
<b>LITTER</b>	Litter Reduction and Recycling	Provides grants for public education, clean up, and recycling efforts
<b>LST</b>	Leaking Storage Tanks	Above or underground storage tanks of petroleum substances
<b>LWC</b>	Livestock Waste Control	Prevent the discharge of wastes from livestock operations to waters of the State
<b>ME</b>	Mineral Exploration	Permits for exploring for mineral resources such as sand, gravel, limestone
<b>NPDES</b>	National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (PCS or LWC)	Permit program that addresses water pollution by regulation point sources that discharge to waters of the state
<b>OCF</b>	Operator Certification Program	Certifications of wastewater treatment facility operators
<b>OWT</b>	Onsite Wastewater Treatment	Any type of individual septic tank or domestic lagoon Any facility that is not connected to a WWF plant
<b>PCS</b>	NPDES Permits and Compliance Section	Discharge of monitored pollutants to waters of the state: WWF for industrial or domestic wastewater. Remediation wells, discharge of cooling water, discharge of monitored pollutants from storm water or construction sites which are 5 acres or larger
<b>POC</b>	Pool Operator Certification	Certifications of pool operators
<b>PRR</b>	Petroleum Release Remediation	Petroleum release sites eligible for Title 200 reimbursement funds
<b>PWO</b>	Public Water Operators	Certifications for public water operators

<b>RA</b>	Release Assessment	Receives notifications of spills, leaks, and other environmental emergencies and provides technical assistance and regulatory oversight to those that pose an immediate hazard on either the environment or public health
<b>RAP</b>	Remedial Action Plan Monitoring	Voluntary cleanup of any site
<b>RCR</b>	Resource Conservation Recovery	Hazardous waste contamination of groundwater, soils, or other materials
<b>SRF</b>	State Revolving Fund	Loans for wastewater and drinking water projects
<b>SF</b>	Superfund	Identifies, assesses, and characterizes sites where hazardous substances are known or suspected to pose a threat to the environment.
<b>SW</b>	Surface Water	NE Surface Water Quality Standards: Title 117
<b>SWG</b>	Source Water Grants	Grant agreement program for protecting the states source water.
<b>TL3</b>	SARA Title III Reporting	Voluntary reporting of hazardous chemical storage
<b>TRI</b>	Toxic Release Inventory	Provides information about toxic chemical releases
<b>UIC</b>	Underground Injection Control	Septic tanks that handle things other than domestic waste, or large capacity. Injection or discharge of monitored fluids into a well, including non-domestic wastewater and open loop heat pumps
<b>WAP</b>	Weatherization Assistance Program	Grant program that enables low-income families in Nebraska to reduce their energy bills by making their homes more energy efficient.
<b>WHP</b>	Wellhead Protection	Protection of public drinking water supplies through Wellhead Protection Area maps and plans
<b>WRR</b>	Waste Reduction and Recycling Grants	Provides grants to private, non-profit, and government organizations to finance integrated waste management programs and projects. Funded by
<b>WS</b>	Well and Septic Evaluation	Evaluations of domestic water supplies and onsite wastewater treatment systems at the request of homeowners, purchasers, or mortgage lending institutions.
<b>WWF</b>	Wastewater Facilities	Review of plans for a change in sewers systems
<b>WWP</b>	Water Well Professionals	Licensing of water well professionals
<b>WWS</b>	Water Well Standards	Compliance and monitoring for the water well standards
<b>319H</b>	Nonpoint Source Water Quality Grants (Section 319)	Federal government awards funds to NDEE to provide financial assistance for the prevention and abatement of nonpoint source water pollution.
<b>401</b>	401 Water Quality Certification	Administers the Section 401 Water Quality Certification Program in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act
