- Non-Community water systems must publicly post Form 6 in locations most consumers will see it (i.e., front door, front desk).

Within 10 days of delivering Form 6, the System must provide the Department:

- Certification of Public Notification (this form).
- Lead & Copper Results Report (Form 5).
