

Lead and Copper Result Public Notification Certification

Within 30 days of receiving lead & copper results:

- Fill out Consumer Information About Lead and Copper (Form 6) for each sample site and provide it to each resident or location where a lead and copper sample was taken.
- Community water systems must either **mail** or **hand deliver** Form 6 to each resident.
- Non-Community water systems must **publicly post** Form 6 in locations most consumers will see it (i.e., front door, front desk).

Within 10 days of delivering Form 6, the System must provide the Department:

- Certification of Public Notification (this form).
- Lead & Copper Results Report (Form 5).
