## **PERMIT FEES**

There are no permit fees. The permit will be issued for a one-year period and will be renewed annually. Annual reports covering the hauling activities for the previous calendar year and new permit applications must be submitted each year to qualify for a permit renewal. The permit period will be from April 1 through March 31.

6. Permitted waste tire haulers who do not accumulate, collect, or process waste tires must establish and maintain financial assurance in an amount equal to \$5,000.00 if you haul 100,000 whole tires measured in passenger tire equivalents (PTE)\* or less per year or equal to \$10,000.00 if you haul over 100,000 whole tires measured in PTE per year. Identify the financial assurance mechanism you will use as described in Title 132. The alternatives allowed for a waste tire hauler permit are a letter of credit, a surety bond, or an escrow account. An originally signed copy of the financial assurance must be submitted to the Department before the initial issuance of the permit. After the initial permit is issued the financial assurance mechanism does not have to be resubmitted each year the permit is renewed unless there are changes in the waste tire hauler's operation that would require changes in the financial assurance. **\*Passenger tire equivalents (PTE) are defined as twenty pounds by weight of waste tire or processed waste tire.**

7. Permitted waste tire haulers that also accumulate, collect, recycle, or process waste tires must establish financial assurance in the amount equal to \$1.25 per PTE for the maximum amount of passenger tire equivalents of waste tires and waste tire material, except crumb rubber, that is accumulated on site at any one time. Identify the financial assurance mechanism you will use as described in Title 132. The alternatives

allowed for a waste tire hauler permit are a letter of credit, a surety bond, or an escrow account. An originally signed copy of the financial assurance must be submitted to the Department before the initial issuance of the permit. After the initial permit is issued, the financial assurance mechanism does not have to be resubmitted each year the permit is renewed unless there are changes in the waste tire hauler's operation that would require changes in the financial assurance. Permitted waste tire haulers that also accumulate, collect, recycle or process waste tires must provide an estimate of the maximum amount of passenger tire equivalents of waste tire material, except crumb rubber, that is accumulated on site at any one time. Waste tire material is defined as any form of waste tires.
