



Weatherization Program Bulletin 23-3 Effective Date: July 1, 2023

Subject: Update of the Nebraska Weatherization Assistance Program's (NeWAP) three-year average fuel prices for use on Energy Audit Reports run on or after July 1, 2023.

Purpose: As per the Department of Energy (DOE) Approved NeWAP Policies and Procedures Manual dated 8/10/2022, the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy (NDEE) will provide NeWAP Subgrantees with a three-year average state fuel costs to be included in their NEAT/MHEA Setup Library and used for running site specific energy audits. Additionally, as per WPN 22-10 the NeWAP has been approved to include DOE's Social Cost of Carbon (SCC) in the fuel prices used in energy modeling/auditing of homes weatherized through the NeWAP.

The following table shows the Nebraska three-year averaged fuel prices as well as the DOE established fuel modifiers approved for implementation.

Scope: The provisions of this WPB apply to all NeWAP Sub-grantees that receive financial assistance through the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy (NDEE) under the Department of Energy's (DOE) Weatherization Assistance Program.

Procedures:

As indicated in the "Effective Date" of this WPB, NeWAP Subgrantees are to update their NEAT/MHEA Setup Library to include these updated three-year average fuel prices (including the DOE SCC Modifiers) for use on Energy Audit Reports run on or after July 1, 2023.
